230 Christians were abducted last February, on 22 February this year, the final 43 were released!

SYRIA | Captives released from Islamic State

On the 23rd of February 2015, 230 Christian men, women and children were abducted by the Islamic State, in a raid on Christian villages along the Khabour River. Information on their condition only came in glimpses, a video showing the execution of two men in October and occasional releases, numbering in the tens at best.

GOD AT WORK

As of 22 February this year, all 230 have been accounted for. The final 43 Christians being held have been released. The Assyrian Church has thanked everyone for supporting their community throughout this ordeal. While the Assyrian community has suffered substantially from the Islamic State, they have remained faithful and God has protected His people in this difficult time.
