BANGLADESH

"We will kill those who preach Christianity one by one."

While Bangladesh ranked No. 43 on the World Watch List for 2015, recent sectarian violence has caused concern of growing intollerance. In the first half of the year, four 'Atheist' bloggers were killed by members of the Islamic community and recently pastors have been targeted.

In November, Italian Pastor and missionary Piero Parolari was attacked by gunmen on his trip home from morning prayers. Piero has been working in Bangladesh for more than 25 years as a doctor at a local hospital run by Christians. After the attack, he was rushed to hospital where doctors stabilised him and managed to control his severe injuries.

Several pastors have also recently received threats in the form of text messages and letters. Pastor Barnabas Hembrom received one of the letters and shared from it, "We will kill those who preach Christianity one by one." While the Islamic State has claimed responsibility for the attacks and threats, the government denies they are in the country. They assert that it is more likely a local Islamic extremist group.
